



FINALS INFORMATION & SPECTATOR EXPECTATIONS

CONGRATULATIONS ON MAKING THE FINALS!

It is Vixens' policy that all registered players for a team will play a **minimum of 50% game time**, unless injured or on a permit for finals. The **15-week fixtured season is guaranteed** – finals are a **bonus** and played to **win**.

A FRIENDLY REMINDER

These are kids playing. This is a game. Our coaches are volunteers, and our umpires are human. Let's encourage our players to **enjoy netball**.

SPECTATORS — WHAT WE EXPECT FROM YOU

- Have fun, be positive, and show respect.
- Celebrate effort and good play.
- Respect umpires, officials, and players.
- Remain behind the line to protect the umpire's run.
- Encourage — mistakes happen.
- Enjoy being a spectator.

DON'T BE *THAT* SPECTATOR

- Using offensive language or gestures.
- Threatening physical violence.
- Disputing umpire decisions.
- If you have nothing nice to say, say nothing at all.

FINALS POLICY — KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Spectators will be positioned on the alternate side of the court (SNA will direct). Only coaches, players, and officials are allowed on the benches.
- Spectators **cannot** approach the scorer. Scores will be updated on the whiteboard each quarter.
- Umpires deliver and return the scorecard.
- **Two timers** required:
 - Game timer
 - 2-minute time-out & 30-second injury timer
- **Two game balls**: one on court, one with scorer/timer. Ensure our ball is pumped.
- Timer follows the umpire for the **last 10 seconds** of each quarter — another person must watch the scorecard.
- Scorecard **cannot leave** the scorers' box.

IF THE GAME IS DRAWN

- Play **2 × 7-minute halves** with a 2-minute break.
- SNA Committee may replace scorers/timers.
- If still drawn, play continues until a team is **2 goals ahead**.
